A D V O C A T E S

Positions of the Juneau League include:

- ✓ **Local Government** — Assembly representation from specific districts elected at-large works well.
- ✓ **Recreation** — Public agencies must provide sufficient open space and activities for its citizens.
- ✓ **Planning** — Balanced development should improve the physical environment in the interest of the whole community.
- ✓ **Domestic Violence** — All individuals have the right to be safe from abuse and neglect. Governments should share the responsibility for citizens' health and safety.
- ✓ **Education** — Student/teacher ratios should not exceed 20/1 in K-3 and 25/1 in grades 4-12; district-wide elementary testing and special needs services are necessary.
