#### **Summary:**

- We had 27 people respond to the survey. This constituted a quorum.
- The proposed Board of Directors was unanimously approved.
- There was one 'no' vote on the Budget. The comment was: "i can't support a negative budget balance. Please discuss." Also one other concerned comment was: "Conditionally approve; with the rec that it be revisited after the first quarter in light of the impact C vir may have on our fund raising ability."
- There were quite a few comments on the program list. Most particularly, there was not a lot of support for a "climate change" local program. Also a comment that "only pick one update or program as we have a lot to do", and "Perhaps a GOTV effort for first time voters."
- There were a number of comments and suggestions on other things. A third of the comments said that we had enough on our plates for this year; the remaining comments were split among providing more civics in schools, focusing on communicating voting processes, watching for voting restrictions and a program proposed for "supporting Juneau during cruise ship season."
- There were 11 people who volunteered, none that should be new to the board.
